## Cross-Listed Courses and Shared in BAS and BSBA

Strategic Management MAN-3025 is cross listed with Contemporary Management MAN-3026. Similarly, Strategic Marketing MAR-3025 is cross listed with Contemporary Marketing MAR-3025.

### Advising Recommendations:

- 1. If students are moving into catalog year 2023/2024 and they have already taken Introduction to Statistics prior to Spring of 2023 I would approve this as a course substitution in place of Business Statistics.
- 2. If transfer students are moving into catalog year 2023/2024 and they have taken an ethics course prior to Spring of 2023 I would approve a course substitution for Business Ethics.
- 3. The **Advanced Information Systems BIS 3024** course has no prerequisites, and we recommend all students in both BSBA and AA. B to enroll in the course the first or second semester. First offering of this course will be Spring 2024. If the AA.B. students prefer to not pursue the BSBA, BUS 3024 can count as an elective.
- 4. Graduation December 2023: For students who need MAN 4097 Capstone Experience in Fall 2023 to graduate please advise students to enroll in the MAN 4097 Business Strategy course in the Summer of 2023. This is the last time the business strategy course will be offered. Students who need MAN 4097 Capstone Experience in Fall 2023 to graduate we will offer an independent study. We will need your assistance capturing the names of the BSBA students you are advising to prepare in advance to match the student to an appropriate community partner. Additionally, all students taking MAN 4097 Capstone Experience moving forward will be required to enroll in a zero credit MAN 9001 Capstone Experience Orientation a semester ahead of enrolling in MAN 4097.
- 5. MAN-4097 in Spring 2024: Students planning to enroll in MAN 4097 in Spring 2024 will have to enroll in the prerequisite MAN 9001 Capstone Experience in Fall 2023. Yesterday we tested this scenario in colleague with Cory Rikard and Jamie Stoess, everything seems to populate correctly. Keep in mind, in student planner, the MAN-9001 will appear as a prerequisite for the course and it will not appear in the degree plan. This week I will work with the appropriate assistant dean to create the zero credit MAN-9001 Capstone Experience Orientation course for summer and fall 2023. After the 2023-2024 academic year, the orientation course will convert to a one credit course and MAN 4097 will be a 3-credit course after we submit for a curricular change in the Fall of 2023.

# Minors:

Most business upper division course electives are embedded in the minors and require a smaller number of upper division elective credits than in the non-minor option.
